Let's read 1 Timothy 3

Announcement #1!

Focusing on Verses 14-16

1 Timothy 3:14-16 (KJV) *These things write I unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly:*

15 *But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.*

16 *And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.*

A few quick thoughts

- This passage implies that there is a way the church ought to behave, and ways it ought not. (v15)
- In his second letter to Timothy, Paul called this good way a “pattern.”

2 Timothy 1:13 (NLT) Hold on to the pattern of wholesome teaching you learned from me—a pattern shaped by the faith and love that you have in Christ Jesus.

- The Church of Jesus Christ is the “pillar and ground” of truth. Those hungering for righteousness should be able to look to the Church! (v15)
- The motive for holding to the pattern is the Gospel! (v16)
- **This heart to conform and reform for Christ has motivated us for years...**

Our History

- We began as *Closer Walk Christian Fellowship* in 1997
- Our goal was to “Create Complete Christians” or in essence, make Disciples!
- We changed to *Calvary Revival Church Chesapeake* in 2005. At one point, there were 5 “CRCs” total.
- Ironically, we began expository preaching in earnest around the same time (2005-2007).
- **The process of walking line by line through Scripture produced major adjustments. God’s Word changes us!**
- We’ve been blessed to mature and grow in the Word, but that growth meant some pain! :)

Growth in the Scriptures!

Because we believe in following the pattern of Scripture for the church, we have some unique (but biblical and historic) beliefs and practices:

- Finding contentment and peace in Christ alone. **Jesus is Enough!**
- A belief that the “whole Gospel” must be preached. (Acts 20:27)
- Holding to expository preaching where the Text drives the message (2 Tim 4:2)
- Living out a loving holiness (John 14:15; 1 Pet 1:16)
- Seeing the pattern of worshipping with our children as something beautiful (2 Chr 20:13; Ez 10:1; Lk 18:16)
- A biblical view of men’s/women’s roles in the home and church (Eph 5; Col 3; 1 Tim 2-3; Titus 2)
- Believing the *primary* discipler of children are parents (Deut 6; Eph 6)
- Living with as little debt as possible (Prov 22:7; Rom 13:8)
- Pursuing biblical Hospitality and Community (Rom 12:13; 1 Pet 4:9)

This growth however, created a bit of an identity crisis. We have an answer for this...

Why “REFORMATION?”

- Because of God’s Word, we have been “Reforming.”
- We are not referring to a brand of theology; we mean that we have been conforming to the precepts, principles, and patterns of Scripture as a congregation with the Holy Spirit’s help.
- **To reform means “to return to a good state” or to “go back to biblically intended purposes.”**
- *Jeremiah 6:16 (KJV) Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.*
- *2 Thessalonians 2:15 (KJV) Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.*
- **Biblical Reformation is the intentional act of continually returning to God’s Word for His glory and our good!**

Our LORD's Example

Matthew 9:35-38 (KJV)

35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

36 But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd.

37 Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly *is* plenteous, but the labourers *are* few;

38 Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest.

7. Jesus commanded prayer for “sent forth” laborers to do what He did.



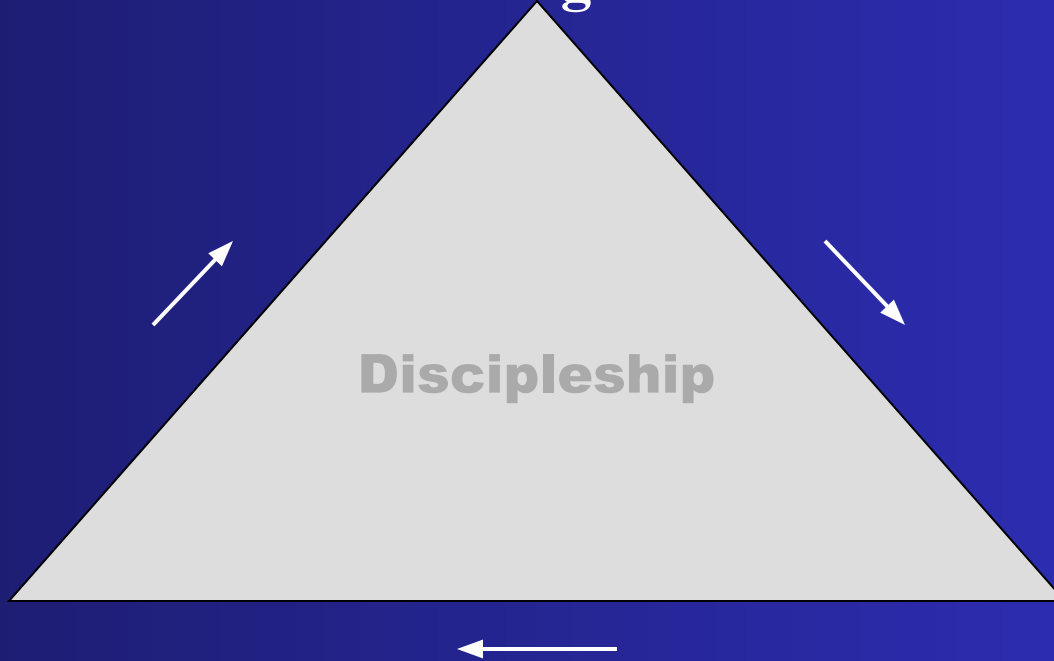

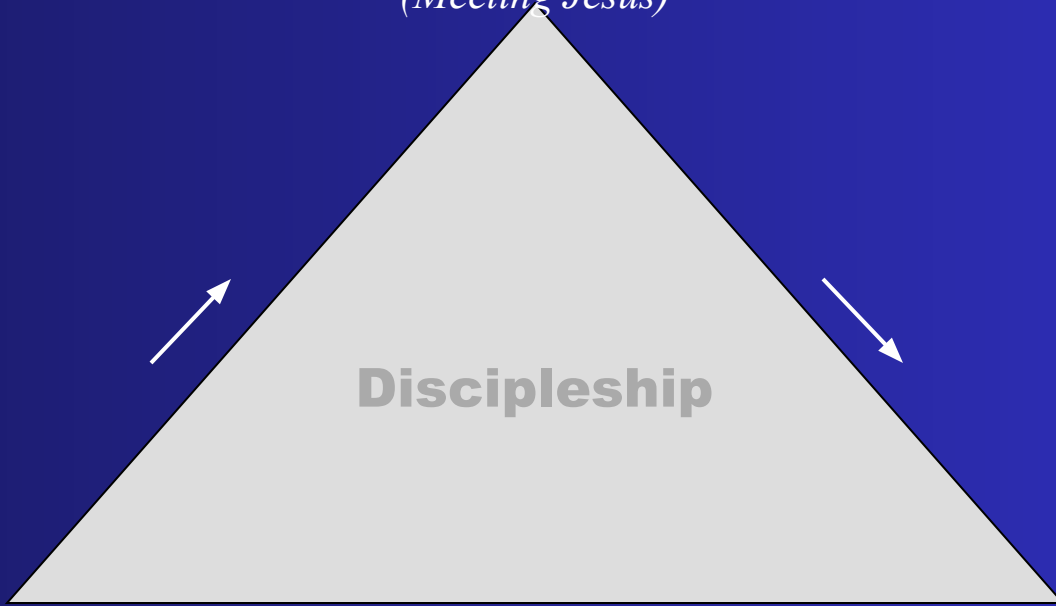

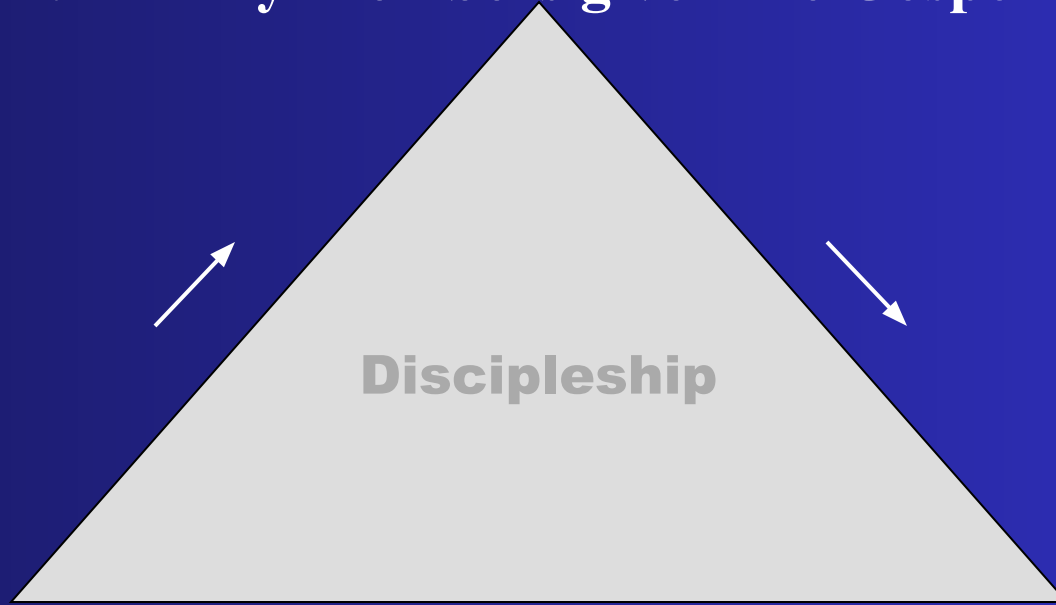
